**COMPUTING:** E-safety.

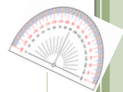
**GEOGRAPHY:** The local area and seasons.

## Homework...

Homework will comprise **Reading**

Every child will have a reading wallet which will include:

- A Reading record. Please sign the Reading record once your child has completed the book. We will change books when we can see that the current book has been completed and signed by a parent. Our days for changing books will be on a Monday.
- If your child is reading 'Ruth Miskin' books they will also receive a paper booklet to read with an adult. This book has key sounds and words as well as recommended questions to ask. These booklets are very helpful in supporting your child's blending skills and their understanding of the book. **Please work through these books verbally but do not write in them.** Thank you
- Read both books and repeat as often as possible.

Read other books to your child and have fun sharing .

**Weekly spellings** : A list of between six and ten spellings will be sent home on a Wednesday and also be tested on the following Wednesday.

If your child is not ready for a reduced list of spellings an alternative task will be set..

There will be a weekly spelling test on a Wednesday.
